**NOTICE OF MOTION, RESPONSE DEADLINE
AND HEARING DATE**

1. If you do not want the Court to grant relief sought in the motion or if you want the Court to consider your views on the motion, then on or before **September 23, 2010 at 10:30 a.m.** you or your attorney must do all of the following:

- a. File an answer or objection explaining your position with the bankruptcy clerk's office at the United States Bankruptcy Court for the Eastern District of Pennsylvania, 900 Market Street, Suite 400, Philadelphia, PA 19107. If you mail your answer to the bankruptcy clerk's office for filing, you must mail it early enough so that it will be received on or before the date stated above; and,

3. A hearing on the Motion is scheduled to be held before the Honorable Stephen Raslavich on **September 23, 2010 at 10:30 a.m.** in Courtroom 4, the Robert Nix Building 900 Market Street, Philadelphia, PA 19107.

4. If a copy of the motion is not enclosed, a copy of the motion will be provided to you if you request a copy from the attorney named in paragraph 1(b).

5. You may contact the Bankruptcy Clerk's office at (215) 408-2800 to find out whether the hearing has been cancelled because no one filed an answer.
