AND NOW, this 8th day of Feb, 2010, upon consideration of

the Second Interim Quarterly Request (the "Application") for Payment on Account for Compensation and Reimbursement Of Expenses Of Eckert Seamans Cherin & Mellott, LLC, Co-Counsel for Official Committee Of Unsecured Creditors, for the Period July 1, 2009 through October 31, 2009 (the "Compensation Period"), and after notice and hearing, it is hereby,

ORDERED that the Application is APPROVED; and it is further


ORDERED, ADJUDGED and DECREED that the sum of \$243,231.10 is reasonable compensation for the professional services rendered on behalf of the Committee and \$994.51 is allowed for reimbursement of costs advanced or expended on behalf of the Committee, and it is further

ORDERED, ADJUDGED and DECREED that the Debtors shall pay Eckert Seamans Cherin & Mellott, LLC the fees requested in the amount of \$243,231.10 and actual, necessary expenses in the amount of \$994.51 for the Compensation Period and (ii)
